ICES stock advice

ICES advises that when the precautionary approach is applied, wanted catches¹ in each of the years 2018 and 2019 should be no more than 194 tonnes. ICES cannot quantify the corresponding total catches.

Stock development over time

Landings have been relatively stable over the time period. The available information is insufficient to evaluate stock trends and exploitation status.




Figure 1 Plaice in Subarea 8 and Division 9.a. Official landings (in tonnes). The 2015 and 2016 data are preliminary.

Catch options

The ICES framework for category 5 stocks was applied (ICES, 2012). For stocks without information on abundance or exploitation, ICES considers that a precautionary reduction of catches should be implemented unless there is ancillary information clearly indicating that the current level of exploitation is appropriate for the stock. The stock status relative to reference points remains unknown. The precautionary buffer was applied in 2015 (for the 2016 advice) and is therefore not applied again this year.

Discarding is likely to be >5% of the catch but the information is uncertain; therefore, no catch advice can be given.

Discard data for the last two years are available for some of the fleets only. The available discard rates are variable, but below 10%; therefore, total catch advice cannot be given.
