

Plaice (Pleuronectes platessa) in Subarea 8 and Division 9.a (Bay of Biscay and Atlantic Iberian waters)

ICES stock advice

ICES advises that when the precautionary approach is applied, wanted catches in each of the years 2020 and 2021 should be no more than 155 tonnes. ICES cannot quantify the corresponding total catches.

Stock development over time

Landings have steadily decreased since 2010, with lowest values observed in 2017 and 2018. The available information is insufficient to evaluate stock trends and exploitation status.




Figure 1 Plaice in Subarea 8 and Division 9.a. Official landings (in tonnes). The 2018 data are preliminary. Landings for Subarea 8 for 1999 are incomplete.

Catch scenarios

The ICES framework for category 5 stocks was applied (ICES, 2012). For stocks without information on abundance or exploitation, ICES considers that a precautionary reduction of catches should be implemented unless there is ancillary information clearly indicating that the current level of exploitation is appropriate for the stock. The stock status relative to reference points remains unknown. The precautionary buffer was not applied in 2017 (for the 2018 and 2019 advice) and is therefore applied this year. Discarding is likely to be greater than 5% of the catch, but the information is uncertain; therefore, no catch advice can be given.

Quality of the assessment

ICES estimates of the landings are available from 2014 onwards. Only official landings are available prior to 2014.

The stock definition of plaice in this area is not clear. The bulk of the fishery takes place on the northern boundary of the stock area.

Issues relevant for the advice

Discard data are only available for the last two years for some fleets. The available discard rates are variable, but below 10%. Discarding is assumed to be greater than 5% of the catch, and owing to this uncertainty, total catch advice cannot be given.

Reference points

No reference points are defined for this stock.
