

9.3.6 Blue ling (*Molva dypterygia*) in Subareas I, II, VIII, IX, and XII, and Divisions IIIa and IVa (other areas)

ICES stock advice

ICES advises that when the precautionary approach is applied there should be no directed fisheries for blue ling in these areas for the years 2016 and 2017, and a reduction in bycatches should be considered until the scientific information is sufficient to prove the fishery sustainable. Measures should be implemented to minimize the bycatch. Closed areas to protect spawning aggregations should be maintained and expanded where appropriate.

Stock development over time

Trends in landings suggest depletion in Subarea II. Landings have also declined strongly in Subarea XII from 2002 onwards. Catches in other areas are minor, but there is some evidence of a persistent decline in Subarea IV.




Figure 9.3.6.1 Blue ling in the northeast Atlantic. Catches by subarea.

Catch options

The ICES framework for category 4, 5, and 6 stocks was applied (ICES, 2012). For this stock, current catches are zero and new data available do not change the perception of this stock. Therefore, ICES advises that when the precautionary approach is applied, there should be no directed fisheries for blue ling, and a reduction in bycatches should be considered until the scientific information is sufficient to prove the fishery sustainable. Measures should be implemented to minimize the bycatch. Closed areas to protect spawning aggregations should be maintained and expanded where appropriate.

Quality of the assessment

No standardized abundance estimates are available for blue ling in these areas. Landings reported in the past from Subareas VIII and IX as blue ling (*Molva dypterygia*) are now considered to be Spanish ling *Molva macropthalma*. ICES does not provide advice on the latter species.

The landings data are considered to reflect the abundance of the species in Subareas I–IV. From this it is inferred that the stock in Subareas I and II is depleted. In Subarea XII, the landings trend may also be influenced by decline in effort.
