In 1966, the research was based on the material collected during two trips of industrial fishing vessels, and one trip of the Sea Fisheries Institute's M.T. "Wieczno". They operated in the region of the north-west African coast between 25°44'N and 13°36'N. The period of the trip was February/March 1966. Catches were made with a bottom trawl at a depth of 20-460 m. The investigations concerned the determination of the species composition of the catches, and the percentage of those species occurring most frequently. The analyses were aimed at an identification of the fish communities, on the basis of the species composition in commercial catches.
